



# SEQ Sportfishing Challenge

## Hosted by the Brisbane SFC

**Venue and Date:** Darling Point Sailing Club, Trafalgar St, Manly Harbour, March 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> 2010.

**Eligibility and Nominations:** Only financial members of ANSA are eligible to enter (for insurance reasons). Temporary membership is available for \$10 but must be received by the club in advance. Nominations will be taken in person or by mail prior to the event, or from 6-9 pm on the Friday of the event. **All anglers must be nominated prior to fishing.** Cheques can be posted to PO Box 1022 Fortitude Valley 4006. **Weather:** The SEQ Sportfishing Challenge will be held on the 20th and 21st of March 2010 firm. There will be no cancellations or postponements due to weather to allow people to make travel and fishing plans with confidence. As always, the skipper is responsible for the safety of their boat and crew and we strongly advise against fishing partially smooth or open waters in the event of a strong wind warning. We will have available copies of the latest weather forecasts from BOM.

**Cost:** Senior angler: \$30. Juniors and sub-juniors: Free (but must nominate). Entry includes a BBQ at the Sunday weigh-in, and a goodies bag.

**Facilities:** The Darling Point Sailing club has its own Boat Ramp and includes a large fenced area which will provide security for cars, boats and trailers parked on site. There are toilets and showers available and undercover areas for eating. Competitors are welcome to stay on site, but will need to provide their own bedding or swag.

Hot food will be available on the Friday and Saturday evenings and a free BBQ will be provided for lunch during the weigh-in on Sunday. Free breakfast cereal and coffee/tea etc will also be available. No alcohol will be available for purchase (you may bring your own), but soft drinks will be for sale all weekend.

**Fishing Rules:** Fishing commences at midnight Friday and ceases at 11 am Sunday. There is an **optional** weigh-in between 6-8 pm Saturday evening. Fish weighed Saturday may be upgraded with better fish taken on Sunday. The final weigh-in will commence at 11.30 am Sunday.. Late entries will not be accepted. The presentation of trophies and prizes will commence as soon as practical afterwards.

All boats are to be launched and retrieved between Mooloolaba in the north, Broad Water to the south and Somerset Dam to the west. Fishing boundaries after launch are unrestricted.

All fishing must comply with all current State regulations. Only fish on the current ANSA State Rules eligible species list will be eligible for the competition. Aggregate and Points section can be fished using ANSA divisions 1 to 9 inclusive. Only species listed as game fish in the current ANSA State Rules eligible species list will be eligible if fishing game fish divisions. Tagging and length based sections can be fished on all ANSA QLD divisions including the use of braid. All line class and tippets are to use IGFA or pre-tested line.

**Interclub and Aggregate points trophies will be awarded based on the ANSA points system, for an angler's best 5 fish, with a maximum of 1 of any species. Anglers will also be awarded a bonus 500 points for each additional species..** Anglers may record additional fish for the length prizes.

Fish must be weighed to qualify for the highest point scoring prizes (Section 3). Fish for length base prizes (Section 4), may be released if the capture is recorded with a digital photo including a measuring device and photo tag (photo tag will be supplied with goodies bag when nominating). Fish tagged and released are also eligible for section 4.

Any fish longer than 20 cm may be tagged and counted toward the tagging trophy. Tagging trophy will be determined by adding up tag points for each fish tagged (using the attached schedule). Tagged fish (legal size only) may also be counted towards angler's aggregate points by calculating points from the average weights listed in the table and the line class used.

Billfish may be measured and released (short length – tip of bottom jaw to fork of tail) and weights will be determined by the ANSA billfish weight to length chart.

All fish produced for weighing must be gilled and gutted and properly iced down (fish may first be weighed whole for masters or record claims **prior to the final weigh in commencing**). Fish too large for esky's may be cut into large sections, provided a flap of skin remains intact between the sections so the fish remains in one piece for weighing. All offal and scraps must be removed from the grounds and properly disposed of.

Any protest must be made in writing to the disputes committee within 10 minutes of the completion of the weigh-in. Any decision then taken will be final.

**Awards:** The following items will be awarded Prizes and / or Trophies. Anglers are only eligible for one (1) award in section 2 and one (1) award in section 3 & 4 combined.
