TRINITY BAY NET FREE AREA & MONITORING PLAN

In 2015, a Net Free Area (NFA) was declared in Trinity Bay, including the Barron River and Trinity Inlet, and these waters now form the basis for the ANSA Qld - Cairns Sportfishing Club Trinity Bay Net Free Area Monitoring Plan. The plan was established to monitor fish stocks in the area to measure the benefits to recreational fishers and the wider community of establishing the net free area. To support monitoring efforts, the 2017 Cairns Sportfishing competition will focus on the 8 key species with all information collected being added to the monitoring plan.

BarramundiThreadfin Salmon (Blue & King)Mangrove JackEstuary Cod (Gold & Black Spot)Golden SnapperMackerel (Spanish & Grey)

Javelin fish (Barred & Silver) Queenfish (All)

CATEGORIES

Trophy Fish Award


Southern Brisbane Sports fishing Club is organising a convoy to fish our way to up the conference starting from 13 September2017.
