
Yearly membership fees are locked in at a competitive rate of \$45 for seniors, \$68 for families or \$70 for individuals joining online via Queensland Sportfishers.

This sportfishing journalism scholarship is named after Vic in recognition of his contribution. We are offering the scholarship to help play a part in nurturing the next batch of sportfishing journalists in Queensland.

#### **HOW DO I GET INVOLVED?**

Anyone who resides in Queensland and is interested in making a start in Sportfishing journalism is welcome to apply. There are no age restrictions, but preference will be given to applicants with limited sportfishing journalism experience. Applicants are expected to possess a high level writing proficiency and a willingness to apply this to Sportfishing journalism.

#### WHAT IS IT?

We are the longest running premier sportfishing organisation responsible for considering and awarding sportfishing records in Queensland. One of the record categories we oversee are **Queensland All Tackle Length Based Records**. For this category an angler can fish according to the general ANSA fishing rules with no restriction on line class (All Tackle).

The exciting news for 2018 is that the consideration and awarding of Queensland All Tackle Sportfishing Records are going live! We will load up existing All Tackle Records to a leaderboard and then all online fish entries submitted in the past and future will be automatically considered for All Tackle Record eligibility.

#### **HOW DO I GET INVOLVED?**

From 2018 onwards getting your catch considered for an All Tackle Record is simple! All you have to do is take a photo of your catches on a measure and holding the fish and and submit them via the online fish capture form for automatic consideration. 

## Champion Tagger Award

#### WHAT IS IT?

Insightful Anglers is about fishing practices and behaviours relevant to fisheries conservation, humane dispatch, ethical angling and considering the safety for yourself and others. The very important factors for successful anglers of fishing knowledge, techniques and skills are not covered in this assessment.

Simply fill out the self assessment. In 2018 your results will be linked to your online Angler Portal.



# **CONGRATS BOB DOVER**

Marina has been a real stalwart for recreational fishing for several decades and has lead the change in the way women are perceived in the sport over her time serving both her club, Cairns sport fishing club, and on the ANSA Oueensland executive.

Marina's story began after joining the Cairns Sportfishing Club in 1982, where she became the clubs publicity officer. Knowing very little about sportfishing or ANSA at the time she found the role to be of interest and devoted herself fully to it. She spent four years in the position till she was elected club President. She spent six years in this role with true dedication for both the role and club when she stepped aside for 'new blood. Since then another 6 women have taken up the role as presidents of ANSA Queensland clubs.

Two years later Marina found herself on the ANSA Queensland state Executive. Within two years she was once again at the helm, this time however as the President of ANSA Queensland. During her time in the role she proved both her worth as president but turned some of her biggest opponents into her strongest supporters despite the idea of a women holding the role being both novel to her and many others at the time.

Marina spent her time in the role showing many that women could do the job as well despite the challenges that even many males faced." She pioneered her way through and spent a total of six years in the role before stepping aside and remaining on the executive.

Marina spent a total of 14 years on the state executive when she decided to call it a day. Once asked how she would describe her time with on the state executive Marina replied, "We had egos running rampant; we had strong wills and strong voices; we had hot heads and hard heads and we had initiatives coming out of our proverbials!"

During her active years, Marina pioneered the way forward for women in Sportfishing. During the years she saw many changes to sportfishing such as a move towards length based records, stocked impoundment and SIP funding models and the Burns inquiry into recreational fishing in QLD.

Not only did Marina work hard leading ANSA Queensland into a new age but she is also a champion angler beating some of the best to take out the overall champion in the North Queensland sportfish championships in previous years. In 1992 she was awarded for her commitment by receiving to Eric Miller award.

Marina is still active in the sportfishing world as the secretary of the Caldwell Sportfishing Club and on the organising committee for the Barra Bonanza. She will forever be remembered for her contributions to her club, ANSA Queensland, recreational fishing in Queensland and improving the way women are seen and respected in the sportfishing sector.
