Re: 2020/21 Membership

Dear Fellow Sportfishers,

Supporting our members and affiliated clubs is a priority for QLD Sportfishers. With continuing COVID-19 social distancing laws, QLD Sportfishers understands that, alongside the impact to social activities, members and clubs may come under financial strain.

At a recent QLD Sportfishers executive meeting, my fellow executive and I unanimously agreed to provide relief by way of the following measures,

1. Membership fees will be reduced by 50% for the 2020/21 financial year.
2. Current 2019/20 membership will be extended until 1st January 2021

The extension to the 2019/20 membership effectively extends current membership by 6 months, with the aim of supporting members who may currently be facing financial strain.

We are also pleased to announce that ANSA National have supported QLD Sportfishers by also reducing their fees for 2020/21.

As president of my home club of Hinchinbrook, I understand that each club must make their own decision on how they support their members. QLD Sportfishers does however have an expectation that clubs will at minimum pass on the QLD Sportfishers membership fee reduction to their members.

If members or clubs have any concerns or questions, please do not hesitate to myself or any of my fellow executive.

On behalf of QLD Sportfishers, I sincerely wish everyone a safe passage through these troubled waters, and we look forward to brighter times ahead for our fellow sportfishing community.
