Purpose of this Form

Qld Sportfishers (ANSA QLD) values the health, safety and well-being of all of our members, both on and off the water. This risk assessment form has been developed to assist QLD Sportfishers, and our affiliated clubs, to assess the risks of events and activities that they conduct.

It is the responsibility of the primary event or activity organiser to ensure that all risks are identified and appropriate measures put in place to reduce the likelihood and potential consequences of these risks.

Completing a Risk Assessment

To properly assess, measure and control risks follow the four steps and use the risk matrix below.

- 1. Identify hazards
- 2. Assess risks that may result because of the hazards
- 3. Decide on control measures to prevent or minimise the level of the risks
- 4. Monitor and review the effectiveness of measures

Category of Risk

Low	Acceptable level of risk
Medium	Reduce risk as soon as possible
High / Extreme	Risk must be reduced before proceeding
