
The HINCHINBROOK INTERCLUB CHALLENGE is a 'socially competitive' interclub event for members of ANSA clubs and their family and friends.

#### **Event Rules**

#### **General Rules**

- a) Fish must be captured on rod and reel or handline and must be listed on the eligible species.
- b) Anglers must adhere to all recreational fishing regulations.
- c) Officials reserve the right to disqualify any fish or competitor who they deem has not complied with the event rules.

#### **Boundaries**

Northern Boundary: Northern Tip of Gould Island




Southern Boundary: Southern Tip of Palm Island

#### **Fish Registration**

- a) All anglers MUST submit clear and legible photos of their fish on a measuring device to the officials before the fish registration deadline.
- b) Photos must CLEARLY show the whole fish and the official competition symbol on the measure mat. Failure to do so will result in the fish being disqualified.
- c) The competition symbol will be given out at the briefing on Wednesday night, prior to the start of fishing.

#### **Awards**

**Champion Anglers** - highest points scoring bag of 5 different species of fish.

- ✓ Senior Male & Female
- Female Female

✓ Junior Male & Female

<u>Champion Club</u> – highest average points per fish (total points for club / number fish submitted; a club must submit a minimum of 5 fish to qualify).

<u>Lure Fishing</u> – longest Barramundi and Mangrove Jack captured on lure.



Fly Fishing - highest point scoring bag of 5 different species captured on fly.



Sport Fishing - longest Javelin (male, female, junior male, junior female) captured on bait.

<u>Land based</u> - highest point scoring fish captured while fishing landbased.



<u>The 'UNWANTED' Award</u> – awarded to the club with the lowest average points per fish (total points for club / number fish submitted).

Other Awards - Secret Lengths & Meritorious Captures as decided by officials.

Please note: Only 5 fish in total can be registered per angler regardless of the division (Sport, Lure, Fly).

## **Points Scoring**

Overall Length of Fish  $(cm)^{\#}$  x ANSA Fighting Factor  $(FF)^{*}$  = Points

Example: (63cm barramundi)

 $63cm \times 1.5 (FF) = 94.5 points$ 

T&C's

- All fish registered bust meet minimum length.
- > Refer to eligible species list below for Fighting Factors and minimum fish lengths.
- > Officials will round measurements down to the nearest 0.5cm.
- > In the event of a tie for champion angler, the angler with the highest single point scoring fish wins.
- In the case of a tie for other awards, officials reserve the right to select a winner by any method they deem acceptable.
- Each fish is eligible to win one award only in the Other Awards categories.

## **Participant Responsibility & Liability**

#### **BYO & Consumption of Alcohol**

Event organisers ask all participants and guests to keep alcohol consumption to within moderate levels. Consumption of excessive alcohol will not be tolerated, and appropriate action will be taken to remove heavily intoxicated people from the event and venues.
