There are restrictions regarding boats and gazebos so best contact before booking.

Redcliffe Show - They will allow caravans, Camper trailer or roof top tents, boats, dogs, but NO gazebos swags on stretcher beds or tents. info@redcliffeshow.com

Wescloud Lodge Camping - (near Burpengary) Set on 42 acres, this is a bush camping option with some basic amenities. No power. It is about 20 minutes to MBBC Scarborough and 30 minutes to Sandstone Point.

Boat Ramps

Scarborough Marina (next to MBBC) - 2 lane sheltered concrete ramp, pontoons, bitumen car park, suitable for most boats. Launch here to fish the Bay and Moreton Island.

Coast Guard Ramp (1min from MBBC) - 4 lane sheltered concrete ramp, pontoons, bitumen car park, suitable for all boats. Launch here to fish the Bay and Moreton Island.

Pelican Park Ramp (12min from MBBC) - 2 lane semi-sheltered concrete ramp, pontoons, bitumen car park, suitable for most boats up to 6m, Launch here for southern end of peninsula and pine river.

Kirra St Ramp (50min from MBBC)-2 lane concrete ramp open to the Brisbane River. Limited parking and no pontoon. Can be difficult to use when launching on your own.

Uhlmann Rd Boat Ramp (35min from MBBC) - 3 lane sheltered beach concrete ramp, small pontoons, bitumen car park, suitable for most boats. Launch here to access Caboolture River opening.

Spinnaker Sound Ramp (55 min from MBBC) - 3 lane sheltered concrete ramp, bitumen car park, suitable for all boats. Launch here to access Bribie Passage and Moreton Bay.

Note there are many other boat ramps in the region. There are ramps at Burpengary Creek, Nudgee Beach, Toorbul, Donnybrook, Port of Brisbane and VMR Bribie Island

Fishing area boundaries: Are North to Double Island Point, South to the Tweed River, East to international waters and West to the S.A. / Queensland border.

Weigh Station: RPG&SC has a weigh station and certified scales available for any size fish if anyone would like to weigh a potential record. You can pull up right at the weigh station in your boat.

Itinerary changes: In the event of bad weather or other unforeseen issues, venues or times may need to be altered for the event to carry on.

Photography or social media: Please be aware that photographs taken during the event may be used on ANSA QLD and RPG&SC websites and social platforms and future event advertising.

AGM attendance: ANSA QLD would like to have at least 1 representative from each affiliate club attend the AGM and would like to extend an invitation to any ANSA members to attend the AGM and watch the proceedings.

Fish Captures: Anglers are encouraged to tag fish or keep fish for a feed, and a list of species will be as per the ANSA monitoring schemes at www.ansaqld.com.au/monitoring-plans/
